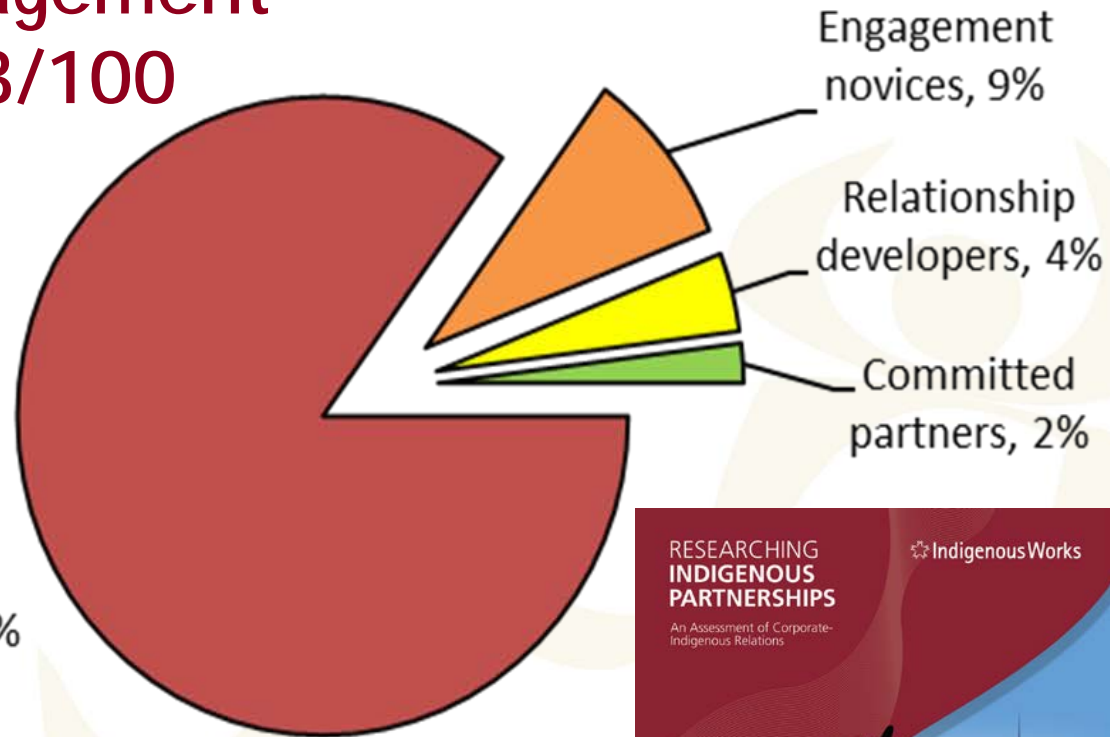


THREE KEY FINDINGS: 511 Companies surveyed

1. Partnership/Engagement Index Score = 13/100

2. 85% Dis-engaged

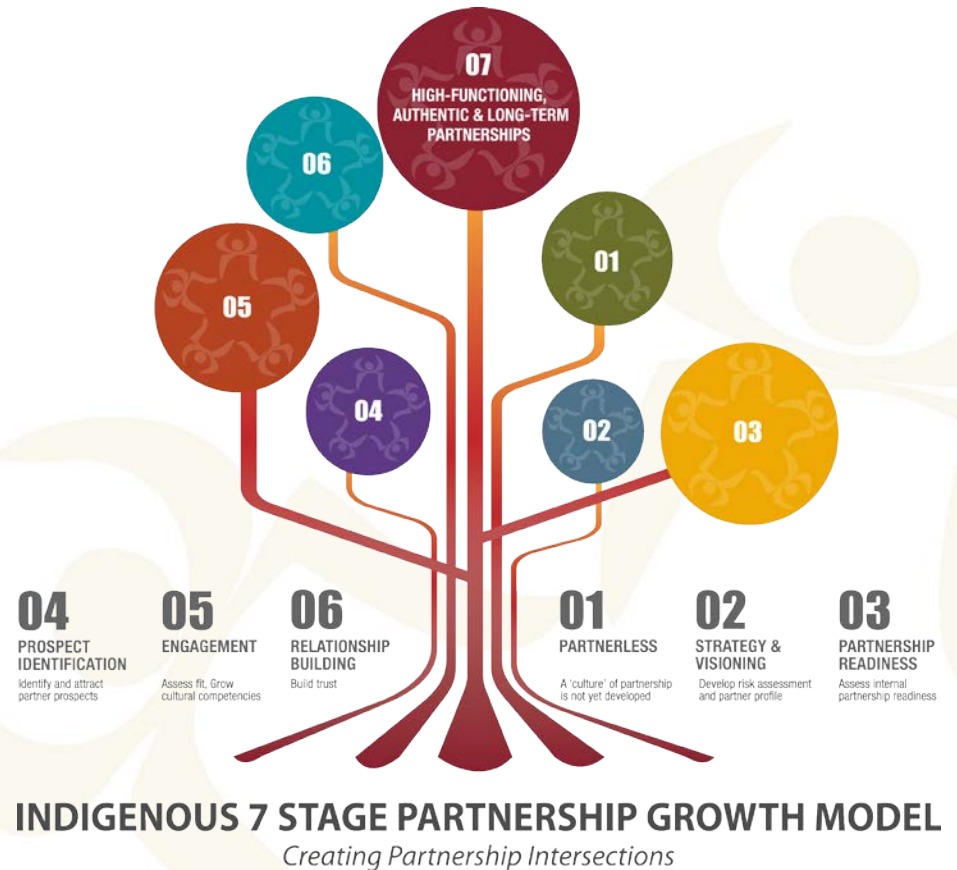
Disengaged majority, 85%



3. Truth and Reconciliation Commission Awareness only 28%
