THE ORGANISATION

THE POSITION

The Métis Women Entrepreneur Business & Credit Analyst is a permanent position reporting to the Director of Business Development.

The incumbent will be responsible for:

- Delivery of the Métis Women Entrepreneur Program
- Providing commercial credit recommendations
- Client relationship development
- Providing advice and information on business operations, markets, products, financial programs, and other related matters to qualifying businesses and entrepreneurs
- Delivering business training and workshops to Métis Women Entrepreneurs in the community to assist them with starting or growing their businesses
- Promote a welcoming environment for Métis women
- Perform other related duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE

- Degree or Diploma in commerce, business administration, economics, finance, math, science, information technology or equivalent;
- Strong MS Excel Skills;
- Strong Writing Skills;
- Practical understanding of the issues facing small business entrepreneurs and the ability to work and communicate effectively with them, specifically in Métis communities;
- Experience working effectively and collaboratively with Métis communities and organizations and/or a willingness to learn about Métis culture and traditions
- Ability to travel extensively and a valid driver's licence and vehicle necessary for travel in the region

The position will be based in one of Kenora, Dryden, Fort Frances, or Atikokan Ontario.

Salary will be commensurate with experience and qualifications and a comprehensive benefits package, including a generous group RRSP contribution, life, disability, extended health care, and relocation assistance.



In meeting the objectives and vision of the organization, preference may be given to individuals who are Citizens of the Métis Nation of Ontario or registered members of other Métis organizations recognized by the Métis National Council.
