The Position

Reporting to the IT Manager, the Senior IT Analyst will develop, test, deliver and/or document system requirements, implementation plans, IT policies and procedures, and provide advice on a wide range of IT issues. The successful candidate will lead the development and implementation of NACCA's Microsoft 365 cloud environment, including SharePoint, OneDrive, Exchange, etc.

Key Responsibilities

Information Systems:

- Provides technical expertise and project coordination services to support and maintain continuity of the organizations computer systems and networks
- Works with users in the development of computer programs and in the day-to-day support of business systems and infrastructure
- Design, develop, integrate, test, and implement information systems business solutions
- Provide advice on information systems strategy, policy, management, security, and service delivery
- Lead IT projects from requirement gathering to implementation, providing user support and the business perspective to the development of a system, and performing quality assurance testing and planning

Systems Security:

- Confer with clients to identify and document requirements, assess physical and technical security risks to data, software, and hardware
- Develop policies, procedures, and contingency plans to minimize the effects of security breaches
- Takes a lead role in the development, implementation, and maintenance of the data recovery aspects of the organization's disaster recovery plan

Information Systems Quality Assurance:

- Develop and implement policies and procedures to maximize the ease-of-use, efficiency, effectiveness and overall quality of software products and information systems
